ST.GEORGE'S DAY MESSAGE 2023

hen we as Scouts gather today on 23rd April, in various places aroundthe world, we do so to pay tribute to St. George, as we make again our Scout Promise.

Lord Baden-Powell chose St. George as the Scout movement's role model because of the qualities and values that St. George stands for.

According to the legend, George was a knight who went into battle against the dangerous and evil dragon to save a princess whom the dragon wanted to eat. He fought the dragon and killed it. He did not do this to get honour and glory, nor to get half the kingdom and the princess promised as a reward to whoever could slay the dragon, he did it because it was the right thing to do and he rode on into the world without claiming his reward. In doing so, he came to stand as a role model and a symbol of some of the things that we as scouts should stand for, courage, strength, orderliness, honesty, and doing what is right, without expecting to get something for doing it.

The dragon became something we associate with evil, bad and dangerous, something which must be fought. Now today, there are not big dangerous dragons that need to be killed, or princesses that need to be saved but many of us humans have little dragons inside ourselves, dragons that have to be fought every day and we all know some of them. For children, it might be the teasing that makes you tease someone else until that person gets upset, or the disobedience that makes you not listen to what your parents say. It can also be the bad dragon that makes you harm animals or other people.

Adults also have some dragons to fight and very often they are so big and dangerous that they do great harm to other people. Just think of all the people who have had to leave their homes due to wars in the world.

> Now if all of us Scouts stand together all over the world and try to fight these dragons and also continue to do this as adults, then we are on our way to making the world a better place to live in, just as our founder Baden-Powell told us to do.



In building of **lodge** are **beds**. So in the complex will be also ready **tents**.




You will need **take with you** dining utensils, sleeping bag and mat.

REFORESTATION OF BURNT AREAS

n the 14th of January 2023 in Pedro Bernardo (Avila), a village in Spain, a reforestation of areas burnt in the last summers was organised. This village has had four big fires in the last 30 years. But the Asociación Vecinal Pedro Bernardo Siempre Verde and the Plataforma Planta Un Árbol Scout organised this activity.

More than 170 scouts from Grupo Scout Nómadas (WFIS), Grupo Scout Hotara (WFIS) and Grupo Scout

Tomahawk (ORUS) participated in this activity.

The activity was divided into two parts. The first part of the activity was in the morning where all volunteers were divided into three groups: the Beavers did a seed bomb workshop following the "Nendo Dango" method, for future reforestation. The Cubs did the Bernaldo Bear route

where they sowed seeds and saw what a varied forest of autochthonous species looks like and finally the Scouts and Rovers did the planting of leafy species such as chestnut, rowan, ash, arraclan, kerquiaceae such as oak, holm oak, cork oak, gall oak and other shrub species such as cornicabra, strawberry tree, or holly in an area conditioned and protected with a fence against herbivores, created specifically to ensure the survival of the species planted.

A natural encounter that has served to form a mixed forest which, when it matures, will be a point from which the seeds will spread and expand the species that form it, thus recovering and increasing the biodiversity of the forest. After lunch, the activity was completed with

> a photographic gymkhana around the village where the Scout groups were able to walk around and get to know some of the most characteristic places of the Balcón del Tiétar.

This activity was very appreciated by all and even appeared in several digital and printed newspapers of the province.





It looks they can. We follow the scout law, the one promulgated by Baden Powell. In so many countries, the 4th law says: "The scout is everybody's friend and brother of other scouts". Is it possible, the ones this Federation has lost this article? May it be erased by a kind of magic? Or it may be changed by government laws...

As a first thought, the public opinion (the non-scouts related) will feel there are real and fake scouts. And since we have not the luck of having catacombs like our roman brothers do, we are going to have to do our activities lost in the fields. Well, let me tell you this is NOT going to happen.

We keep teaching unpolitical, secular, integrating, feminist, sincere and traditional scouting, and we will keep doing it. We will keep being proud of being the first Scouts Association internationally recognized by a Federation.

There will be a winner and each participant will receive a participation certificate.

THE ACTIVITY WILL HAVE ONLY ONE PHASE:

Each participant must send by October 31, 2023 a maximum of 4 photos of his/her handicraft by e-mail to handcraft@wfis-europe.org indicating: name, surname, association, group and, most important of all, the age!

Each participant may participate with only one handicraft.

So... start working! The judges are already waiting to see all your wonderful works!

PIONET... 2023

► It's for all European Patrols

- > 2 phases in which the Patrols will be evaluated
- the Patrols will have to work very hard to win!

PIONET... is a pioneering competition for Patrols, with complex and elaborate pioneering constructions, with an adequate design, a perfect technical realization and an equally important presentation of the construction.

The final result will be the sum of the work of the Patrols, so the report will have to show in particular the contribution that each Scout has given.

THE ACTIVITY SHOULD BE DEVIDED INTO TWO PHASES:

First phase: each Patrol must do a complete design of the structure and calculation of the materials and a report in English must be submitted, as detailed as possible, by July 31, 2023. The report must include the name, a photo and the role of each Scout in the Patrol. All reports must be sent by email to:

All reports must be sent by email pionet@wfis-europe.org **2**Second phase: realization and consequently, submission of a detailed report with photographs by December 31, 2023.

- The works will be evaluated by "professionals".
 The sum of the votes of each individual phase will provide the final classification.
- There will be three prizes for the first three classified Patrols.
- Each Scout that participated will receive a badge and each Patrol a participation certificate.
